- There was not an official date but it was really put into action around 1927.

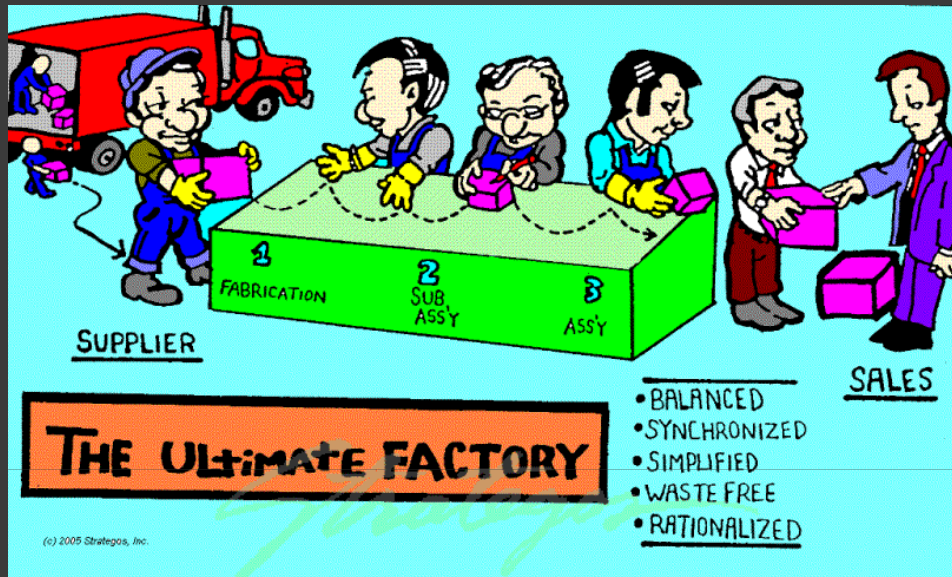
1927
